Summary: As a Procurement & Warehouse Associate, you will assist and support our Supply Chain at our headquarters. You will be responsible for the planning and procurement of materials for our solar installation teams. You will also manage inventory and determine when replenishment orders are required.

Procurement

- Supporting execution of a supply chain management strategy based upon continuous monitoring and forecasting of demand to supplement replenishment of materials.
- Assisting in executing the purchasing strategy to supply projects with on-time delivery to our warehouses while monitoring budgetary impacts.
- Supporting operations and logistics in all procurement and logistical needs to include materials purchasing and warehouse management/inventory to facilitate solar project builds.
- Supporting the Residential Operations Manager and Commercial Project Managers in all facets of procurement, logistics, and forecasting.
- Maintaining relationships with vendors and distributors to ensure project schedules and budgets are successfully achieved.
- Developing and maintaining vendor relationships.
- Coordinating with internal engineering and construction teams, as well as key vendors, on equipment specifications and delivery timing through scheduled weekly meetings and ondemand requests.

Warehouse Management

- Prepare and ship material from the warehouse, bulk and individual lots
- Conducts/participates in physical inventories to verify stock and losses
- Manage delivery trucks (receiving stock and/or filling orders)
- Deliver material or items as needed
- Maintain manual and electronic documents, files and records (such as purchase orders, receipts, delivery logs, inventory, etc.)
